

3. How to apply

- a) Information brochure cum application form can be obtained from Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Kumaun University, Bhimtal Campus, Bhimtal or can be downloaded from the University/ Department website, www.kuntl.in/ www.kudops.org
- b) Application must be sent on the prescribed format along with a demand draft of **Rs. 1500/-** (One thousand five hundred only) **Rs.750/-** (seven hundred fifty only) in case of SC/ ST candidates, in favour of '**Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences- M. Pharm. course**', payable at **Bank of Baroda, Nainital** so as to reach the Department on or before 09 July, 2011.
- c) **Documents Required to be attached along with the application form:** Self-attested photocopies of certificate in support of educational qualifications, GPAT score; experience and category certificate (in case of SC / ST / OBC candidates).
- d) Application form complete in all respects should reach, **The Head, Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Kumaun University, Bhimtal Campus, Bhimtal, 263136, Uttarakhand** by hand/speed post/ registered post on or before 09 July, 2011 (4 p.m.). The Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences shall not be responsible for any delay.

4. Details of Seats

There shall be 72 seats; out of which 60 seats will be open and 12 seats are sponsored seats. Reservation will be as per State Govt. rules. The seats may be increased or decreased at the discretion of the University without any further notification.

5. Fee Details

- a) **For open seats:** Rs. 1,25,000/- per annum + other fees as per university norms (Including Exam fees, Enrollment fees, Caution Money etc.)
- b) **For Sponsored Candidates:** Rs. 2,25,000/- per annum + other fees as per university norms (Including Exam fees, Enrollment fees, Caution Money etc.)

6. Eligibility Criteria

For admission to first semester of M. Pharm course the candidate should have passed the examination for the degree of B. Pharm of this University or any other University/ institute in India, recognized as equivalent thereto by the University with atleast 50% marks in aggregate

Note:

- (i) Preference will be given to GPAT qualified students.
- (ii) Candidates sponsored by the Industry/Academic Institutions have to produce sponsorship certificate from competent authority.

7. Selection Procedure

- a. Selection to M. Pharm. would be based on valid GPAT score

b. In case of the seats remaining vacant the selection of non GPAT students would be based on merit of entrance examination/ interview/ merit of qualifying examination as per the decision by the university.

8. General Notes

- The decision of University for the selection of candidates shall be final
- Candidates should visit our website regularly for updates / any other matters related to admission procedures.

9. How to Reach the Department:-

Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Bhimtal Campus is situated in the upper banks (Mallital) of the Bhimtal Lake along embankments on the Block Road.

The nearest railway station is

Kathgodam (broad gauge) – 24 Kms away

Lalkuan (meter gauge) – 44 Kms away

It is also approachable by road from either from Haldwani (27 kms) or Nainital (22 kms)
